




JFK is the gateway between Europe and America .











Event Space

- → Additional 200,000 square feet of flexible space in the former TWA terminal, including outdoor terraces and an observation deck
- → 45 flexible event rooms

- → 512 guestrooms including 44 suites
- → 5 hospitality suites
- 15,000-square-foot Starstream Ballroom, including pre-function space
- → Events up to 1,600 people
- → 10,000-square-foot fitness facility

Food & Beverage

- → Kosher kitchen
- → Custom food and beverage from cocktails to fourcourse dinners; third-party catering is allowed
- + 6 restaurants and 8 bars

- → 5GB Wi-Fi speed
- Audiovisual and teleconferencing equipment, plus onsite experts


Onsite Experts

- Dedicated onsite event planners and day-of meeting concierge

Transportation

- Public transportation via AirTrain to Penn Station
- → Valet parking

- + 4,000 parking spaces in adjacent garages
- → Bus parking in adjacent garages
- → 100 onsite parking spaces
- → Connected to JetBlue Terminal 5
- → 2-minute, 45-second walk to Terminal 4 (Delta and 30 other carriers)
- → 5-minute AirTrain ride to all other terminals



Hotel Highlights

- → 200,000-square-foot heart of the hotel in the landmark 1962 Eero Saarinendesigned former TWA terminal
- → 1962 aesthetic throughout the hotel
- → 512 ultra-quiet guestrooms (the hotel's glass curtain wall is seven panes thick)
- → 6 restaurants and 8 bars
- → Rooftop pool and 10,000-square-foot observation deck overlooking runway 4L/22R
- Lockheed Constellation "Connie" L-1649A Starliner repurposed as a cocktail lounge and positioned on the tarmac between the hotel and Terminal 5
- High-end retailers and services

- Museum focused on the Jet Age, the midcentury modern design movement and TWA
- → Authentic Solari splitflap departures board with authentic original mechanical operation
- → 10,000-square-foot stateof-the-art fitness center
- First of a kind hybridized microgrid: entirely off-grid cogeneration plant
- > Free lightning fast Wi-Fi
- → Valet parking
- → Accessible to all terminals via AirTrain
- → Connected to JetBlue Terminal 5 via Saarinen's iconic flight tubes made famous by the 2002 film Catch Me If You Can
- → LEED certified
